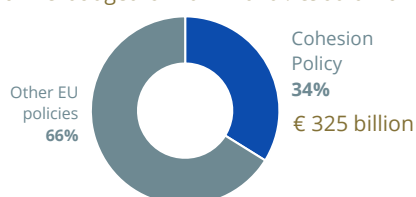

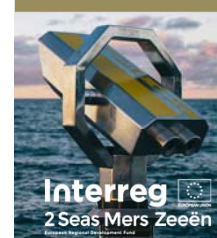
The EU policy framework 2014 - 2020

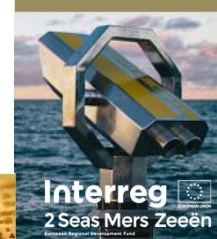
Thematic concentration
