## 2 Seas Applicant Seminar for UK Applicants – 8th Call for proposals – Step 1 (Concept Note)

### **I. About this seminar**

This seminar is for all applicants to the 2 Seas Programme and especially those aiming to participate in the 8th Call for proposals, of which step 1 (Concept Note) closes on 8 April 2019.

This seminar is aimed at those interested in applying as Partners, Observers or Lead Partners, and will cover the project development as well as the application process. It looks at the intervention logic to be addressed by projects and on developing a quality Concept Note. There will also be time to discuss individual applications.

Although the Lead Partner is responsible for submitting the application, all Partners are expected to contribute to drafting it. English-speakers have a special responsibility to ensure that the text in English makes sense and does the proposal justice. It is also useful for non-Lead Partners to be aware from the start what the responsibilities are in joining a project as a Partner or Observer.
