Call for Proposals

The Call 7 Step 1 submission deadline is sneaking up on us. Note that the Electronic Exchange Platform will not accept Concept Notes later than **21 December 2018 (23:59 CET)**.

Applicants will receive recommendations on their Concept Notes at the beginning of April 2019 and will then get the chance to submit a full Application Form by 6 September 2019 (23:59 CET).

Early 2019, a new Call for proposals will be launched. Keep an eye on the Programme website for more Call information.

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Save the date: Mid-Term Review

Halfway through the implementation of the Interreg 2 Seas Programme, it is time to take a step back and look at what the Programme and its projects have achieved so far.

The Mid-Term Review will involve an **exhibition** on project achievements showcasing the 55 approved projects, gathering over 500 organisations and representing a total budget of € 163 million ERDF.



Participants will be invited to take part in **thematic discussions** and to learn about best practices of experienced project partners. This will be a unique opportunity to exchange on successful project management and the concrete added-value of cross-border cooperation.

Finally, the **networking space** and support from the 2 Seas territorial facilitators will enable you to exchange with current and future partners.

2 Seas Seminars

Every Call for Proposals, the Joint Secretariat organises training sessions for both applicants (before project submission) and beneficiaries (after project selection).

Partners of the five projects that have been recently approved (FLAVOUR, Hy4Dense, MOTION, PlastiCity and AGE'IN), are invited to participate at a seminar in Lille in January 2019.

Organisations that will have submitted a Concept Note by 21/12/2018 for Call 7 will have the chance to join for an Applicant Seminar Step 2 in May 2019. Concrete dates and locations will be available early spring 2019.

New projects approved

On 22 November, the Interreg 2 Seas Monitoring Committee approved 5 new projects. Congratulations to all of the partners involved!

Here are brief descriptions of the freshly approved projects:

- FLAVOUR will create socially innovative business models to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of services dealing with food surplus, whilst creating jobs and pathways to employment.
- PlastiCity aims at increasing recycling rates for 'lost plastics' from 20-30% to over 50%.
- The AGE'IN consortium will work out a strategy combining house adaptations with the development of a real local ecosystem for ageing population.
- Hy4Dense will test hydroponics on densely sown crops and work directly with manufacturers and growers to ensure the uptake of this technique.
- The 15 partners of M.O.T.I.O.N will work together to advance development and validation of bionic rehabilitation technology for children with neurological disorders.

Altogether, these projects will receive a total of €16.84 m of ERDF. This means there is still €78.45 m available.
