2 Seas projects

The 2 Seas Programme currently counts 69 projects, all contributing to the innovative, sustainable and inclusive development of the 2 Seas area. In this newsletter issue you can learn how CASCADE and PACE contribute to the Social Innovation of the 2 Seas area.

CASCADE (visit project website)

- aims to develop a financially sustainable approach to elderly/dementia care that can be replicated across the 2 Seas area.
- brings together 10 organisations and is led by The Health and Europe Centre.
- started on 01/04/2017 and will end on 31/03/2021.
- has a budget of € 9 295 278 of which 60% ERDF.





PACE (visit project website)

- establishes research-backed tests that improve access to childcare, with special attention to employment of vulnerable families.
- brings together 12 organisations and is led by the City of Mechelen.
- started on 01/10/2016 and will end on 30/09/2020.
- has a budget of € 6 551 267 of which 60% ERDF.



The Harmonia Village, located in Dover, is a core element of the CASCADE project and will provide longer term and shortterm respite care for people living with dementia which will fully engage with the local community.

Call for proposals

Interreg 2 Seas is currently running its 8th call for proposals. There will be no other calls after this one.

Applicants need to submit a full Application Form by 31 October 2019 (23:59 Brussels time). The MC decision is scheduled for January 2020 and a notification letter will be sent in the first half of February 2020.

Call 7 has closed on 6 September 2019 (23:59 Brussels time). 18 consortia have submitted a full Application Form. The Monitoring Committee will meet on 21 and 22 November to decide on these projects. A notification letter will be sent to all applicants in the first half of December 2019.

The European Week of Regions and Cities is an annual four-day event during which cities and regions showcase their capacity to create growth and jobs, implement European Union cohesion policy, and prove the importance of the local and regional level for good European governance.

Within the framework of the European Week of Regions and Cities a network of 2 Seas regions has joined forces to organise a world cafe.
