Concept Notes can be submitted from 1 August until 27 October 2017. Step 2 (Application Form) will be open from 2 February 2018 until 2 May 2018.

Those who have submitted a Concept Note for Call 4, have the chance to develop a final Application Form over summer. Deadline for these submissions is 13 September 2017.

Meet the project: BioBoost

BioBoost is a project under Specific Objective 4.2 “Circular Economy”. It brings together 3 Dutch, 3 Flemish and 2 British organisations. Another 5 organisations have joined the partnership as observer partners.

The project partners want to drive new bio-based initiatives. “With chain partners (corporate businesses, government and knowledge institutions), we want to use plant ingredients for the benefit of the circular economy, health and welfare,” says Jeroen Straver from the Municipality of Westland, the lead partner of BioBoost.

“It is important for Westland to establish international relations with other horticultural centres in Europe, in order to remain an important international horticultural region. Together with partners from England and Belgium, we want to maintain and expand our international competitiveness in bio-based economy.”
